# Mercy Gilbert Motor Show 'Cruisin' for a Cause'

## Exhibitor Information & Rules and Regulations

**Location:** Mercy Gilbert Medical Center, 3555 S. Val Vista Drive, Gilbert, AZ 85297

**Event Date & Hours:** Saturday, October 2, 2010 from 10 AM – 5 PM.

Exhibitors must not depart prior to event's closing time of 5 PM, and must evacuate the site by 7 PM.

Signage will be posted directing event registrations. There will be separate registration areas for automobile and motorcycle exhibitors. A 'Release of Liability' form will be required to be signed by all exhibitors on event day at registration. No person will be permitted to participate as an exhibitor without signing the release.

**Use of Tobacco:** Mercy Gilbert Medical Center (MGMC) Campus is a non-smoking and tobacco free property. All use of tobacco is prohibited.

**Sales Information:** The Committee reserves the right to decide which exhibitor vehicles and promotions are most suitable for the Motor Show. No radical or commercial vehicles permitted; no commercial signage on the vehicle permitted, unless represented by a Committee approved Sponsor of the event. Exhibitor and exhibitor personnel must wear appropriate apparel. Any exhibitor found with illegal drugs, paraphernalia, controlled substances, other products or displays unsuitable for a family event, or alcohol (other than approved by the Committee as sold through a food vendor), will be required to vacate the event. No refund will be given.

**Set Up:** Exhibitor registration will be begin at **7:00 AM and go through 9:00 AM**, on Saturday, October 2, 2010, ONLY. Exhibitors not present and registered by 9:30 AM will forfeit their space, which will be resold on a first come, first served basis – NO EXCEPTIONS. No refund will be given.

**Parking:** Exhibitors with a trailer or vehicle other than that registered for exhibition are required to park the unregistered vehicle outside the show area in designated locations.

**Exhibitor Space and Assignments:** Exhibitor motor vehicle spaces are approximately 13'6" X 18'; motorcycle spaces are 9'x18'; unless otherwise specified. Exhibitor space is provided and is available on a 'first come, first served' basis upon event day registration. Any special needs or additional space requirements must be presented in writing to the Committee for approval prior to the registration deadline of September 6, 2010. Additional fees may apply. Incomplete applications will not be processed immediately, and your registrations will be held in a 'pending' status with no guaranteed space availability until your complete information is received. NOTE: Exhibitor shall not assign, sublet, share, or apportion the whole or any part of the space allotted without the written consent of the Committee.

### Exhibitor Vehicle and Displays:

1. The Committee reserves the right to reject any exhibitor whose vehicle, décor, or display is deemed inappropriate for the event. Any information regarding the vehicle must be attractively displayed on easels, sandwich boards, etc. Signs and vehicle decor should be in good taste, reflect the event theme, and must not interfere with neighboring exhibitors or attendees. Please keep aisles free of clutter.
2. Engines of the entries must not be operated within the event site between 10 AM and 5 PM. First violation will receive a warning from event security personnel, a second violation will result in disqualification from the judging, and possibly being escorted from the Show.
3. At no time will careless, reckless driving, or unnecessary noise from entries be tolerated.
4. It is recommended that all exhibitors have someone present with their vehicle at all times during the event. *The Committee assumes no responsibility for exhibitor vehicles or property at any time during the event.*

**Release of Liability:** Your signature on a 'Release of Liability' form for Mercy Gilbert Medical Center, Catholic Healthcare West (CHW), staff, committee members, and volunteers will be required upon registration on the day of the event.

**Clean Up:** Exhibitors are responsible for clean up of their area during and after the event. Final clean up begins promptly at 5 PM (close of the event). The Committee will not be responsible for any items left after exhibitor departure.

**Confirmation notices:** Registration confirmation notices will be sent approximately 72 hours after receipt of your application prior to September 6, 2010 (pre-registration deadline).

**Cancellation:** The Mercy Gilbert Motor Show is a fundraising event; therefore, prior payments received from cancellations will be deemed as donations and are, therefore, non-refundable.

**Other:** Only working animals of individuals with disabilities are allowed on the site with prior approval of the Committee.
